Golf Goddesses

The PN Golf Goddesses is a non-competitive, social group with emphasis placed on having fun while improving our game. We have a meeting in mid-March to begin the season. We play Monday afternoons at approximately 2:45 p.m., beginning in early April and continuing through October. There is no cost for joining the league. However, if you want to record your scores to maintain a handicap, there is a \$45 fee.

Ladies' 9 Hole League

Interested in joining a fun golfing group? We play different individual and team games on Tuesday each week until Mid-October. We ask that you have a handicap of 54 or lower, and if you have not established a handicap, you can do so by calling the Pro Shop to get one established. Once a month, on the last Tuesday, we play and have lunch afterwards at the clubhouse.

Our activities begin with a kick-off golf meeting in early April. Dues are \$70 (\$45 league + \$25 for handicap). The \$45 goes into our golf kitty for events, prizes, fee, etc. Make your check payable to the PN 9-hole Women Golfers. You may join any time during the golf season.

Monday Ladies' League -18 Hole

On behalf of the Monday Ladies' Golf, we would like to invite you to join us! There's NO COST to join and no weekly dues! We do ask, however, that you have a Handicap Index of 40 or less from the yellow tees. We are a fun-loving, supportive, and mentoring group of ladies with various skill levels. Can't join now? ... No problem! You may join any time during the season! We play Monday mornings, (starting 0700-0830), April–October, with periodic luncheons after golf. The season includes a nice mix of noncompetitive "Social Golf" and fun Individual or Team Competitions. We look forward to meeting and golfing with you!

PNLGA - 18 Hole Women's League

The PNLGA is open to all PN golf members and non-members with a handicap of 40 or below. We play Wednesday mornings April–October. Dues for membership are \$65.

Men's 9 Holers

The Men's 9-Holers isn't a league per se. It plays early mornings every Tuesday and Thursday during the golf season. Anyone is welcome to participate. Players sign up to play via a spreadsheet for any given Tuesday and/or Thursday throughout the year.

Men's 18 Hole League - PN Men's Golf League (PNMGL)

Gentleman, if you love the game of golf and would like to get out with the guys and play a couple of rounds a week, the Men's 18-Hole Members welcome you to join us! We begin our season the first Monday or Wednesday of April and play each Monday and Wednesday morning thereafter.

The cost of joining the league is \$45.00 (Handicap fee is included in this amount). Our golfers have a range of handicaps, the maximum players Handicap being 36. We play a variety of team games with teams randomly selected prior to each round. Each player pays \$3 a round and the pot is split among the winning team(s) at the end of the round. The number of winning team(s) is determined by the game of the day and number pf players. PNMGL has two annual Scramble tournaments and luncheons, one in the spring and one in the fall.

Men's Penn National Golf Association (PNGA)

PNGA is a group of golfers with wide-ranging handicaps who play for fun and prizes. For 2023 the group has decided to move its events from Saturdays to Fridays. The PNGA will hold its first 2023 event on April 7th, and then on alternate Fridays throughout the season with the Mixed League. Events will generally be shotgun starts at about 8:30 AM, with changes at the discretion of the Pro Shop. After each round, there is a social gathering to "replay" the round and to get to know our fellow golfers better.

Membership dues this year will be only \$10, to cover incidental expenses, and players will ante up probably \$7 at any event that they play to cover prize money, which will include 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places as well as Low Net, Low Gross, and 4 Closest-to-the-Pin awards. A Net Skins game will also be included.

To join the PNGA, complete and submit this registration form by March 25, 2023.

Alternate Saturday Golf Group (ASGG)

The Alternate Saturday Golf Group (ASGG) is expanding and will play every Saturday in 2023. This informal group will generally alternate between Iron Forge and Founders and play every Saturday through the 2023 season, starting usually at about 11:00 AM. The first event will be on April 8th. Team games will vary and each player will ante up \$3 whenever they play to cover prize money which will typically be either winner-take-all or 1st and 2nd places, depending on how many players sign up. There are no membership fees.

PN Mixed League

The Penn National Mixed League is designed to bring neighbors together in a social setting for a friendly round of golf followed by a get-together to discuss the round, meet with neighbors, and enjoy happy hour. This is a mixed league and not necessarily a couple's league – open to everyone! League play starts in early April and is played every other Friday into the fall.

Membership in the Mixed League is very simple – there is no membership fee and no commitment; you just need to belong to a USGA handicap system. You sign up for our email list and you'll be added to the signup spread sheet, and you will get notifications of the tee times and games for each event.

We have team games each week designed for friendly competition between golfers of all skill levels, generally playing off the tee of your choice using handicaps to level the competitions. Teams will be randomly selected with a mix of men and women on each team. Although there's no cost to join the league, each player pays \$3 a round. The pot is split among the winning teams at the end of the round. We gather on the terrace after the round to reward team winners and enjoy camaraderie and happy hour together.
